Companion Toolkit v1.3.4 by Tommy Thurman. Choose a complete reference, a compact selection, or full-page large-type cards.

Choose the right file

Full toolkit: 84 pages

The complete reference, including every worksheet, response branch, provider log and dated resource.

Quick-reference pack: 12 pages

A compact selection from the full toolkit. It is not a large-type pack or a complete incident-response manual. Keep the Post-Incident Response section or full toolkit available.

Large-type cards: 4 full pages

Dedicated Emergency Stop, Four Steps, What Stays Still and First Response sheets. Essential instructions are at least 18 pt at 100% print; brand/footer metadata is smaller.

Printing and navigation

Print at 100% / Actual Size on US Letter. "Compact" means a shorter selection, not permission to shrink the text. Do not reduce the large-type sheets to wallet size.

The selected PDFs preserve the toolkit's printed page numbers, stable tool IDs and page labels. Use the bookmarks to navigate. Toolkit p. 60 remains p. 60 even when it is the first physical page in an extract.

Open 00_OPEN_TOOLKIT.html after extracting the entire ZIP. Its links open the local files; it does not publish a website or collect information.

Version 1.3.4 preserves the toolkit's 84 pages, worksheets, safety instructions, bookmarks, and tool IDs. Public resource routes were checked on 10 September 2026. The four large cards retain their existing instructions and layout.
